[National EMS Assessment](#) - This 2011 National EMS Assessment was commissioned by the Federal Interagency Committee for Emergency Medical Services (FICEMS) and funded through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). The purpose of this document is to describe EMS, EMS emergency preparedness, and 911 systems at the State and national levels using existing data sources. Additional insight on current issues within EMS and disaster preparedness is provided through the findings from four expert panels. Finally, a review and

discussion of existing data sources, data needs, and opportunities for a future recurring national EMS assessment is provided.
