

The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) is recruiting for an Associate Administrator, Maternal and Child Health Bureau (MCHB).

The Associate Administrator for the Maternal and Child Health Bureau plans, manages and directs a national program that: 1) assures access to quality care, especially for those with low-incomes or limited availability of care; 2) reduces infant mortality; 3) provides and ensures access to comprehensive prenatal and postnatal care to women (especially low-income and at risk pregnant women); 4) increases the number of children receiving health assessments and follow-up diagnostic and treatment services; 5) provides and ensures access to preventive and child care services, as well as, rehabilitative services for certain children; and 6) Implements family-centered, community-based, systems of coordinated care for children with special healthcare needs. The Associate Administrator for MCHB provides overall direction to promote the implementation of a broad range of programs that address the needs of the nation's MCH population, the largest of which is the Title V Maternal and Child Health Service Block Grant, as well as discretionary grants focused on key issues in maternal and child health, research, and training of maternal and child health professionals.

This position is in the Senior Executive Service (SES), a small elite group of senior government leaders who possess a diverse portfolio of experience and the strong skills required to lead across organizations. As an SES member you will influence the direction of innovation and transformation of the federal government and lead the next generation of public servants. The executive provides leadership, in partnership with key stakeholders, to improve the physical and mental health, safety and well-being of the maternal and child health (MCH) population.
