




Health and Medical Preparedness Council

Formulates policies and resources to assist states to provide a coordinated EMS response to incidents that impact public health. Provides technical assistance for and representation of state EMS officials regarding both natural as well as terrorist type incidents, to include emerging infectious disease outbreaks, as they relate to planning, preparedness, response and recovery, to include homeland security activities.


