PATT



PATT — Psychomotor Authorization To Test

What is PATT?

How do I get my PATT?

- 1. Program Director signs off on CC or EE in NREMT profile
- Student completes NREMT application
- 3. Student generates PATT with push of a button (My CBT)

PATT is issued

- Expires with course completion date (2 years)
- Roster submitted 14 days before exam (previously 21 days)



^{*}Steps 1 and 2 can occur in either order; both must be done before step 3

PATT — Psychomotor Authorization To Test FAQs

- How long does it take to get the PATT? (no waiting)
- Where is the PATT number located? (My CBT tab)
- Does the PATT number change with each retest?
 - PATT issued for 1st full attempt
 - Different PATT issued for 2nd full attempt
- Does the exam coordinator automatically get the PATT?
 - o Candidates are responsible for giving that information





Early Eligibility Attestation Statement

The Program is state-approved and CAAHEP-accredited or subject to a current CoAEMSP-issued LOR. I hereby attest that the candidate(s) identified here have successfully completed all requirements of our approved Paramedic program and state EMS office.

Course Completion Attestation Statement

The Program is state-approved and CAAHEP-accredited or subject to a current CoAEMSP-issued LOR. I hereby attest that the candidate(s) identified here have successfully completed all required didactic coursework and the laboratory portions of our approved Paramedic program.

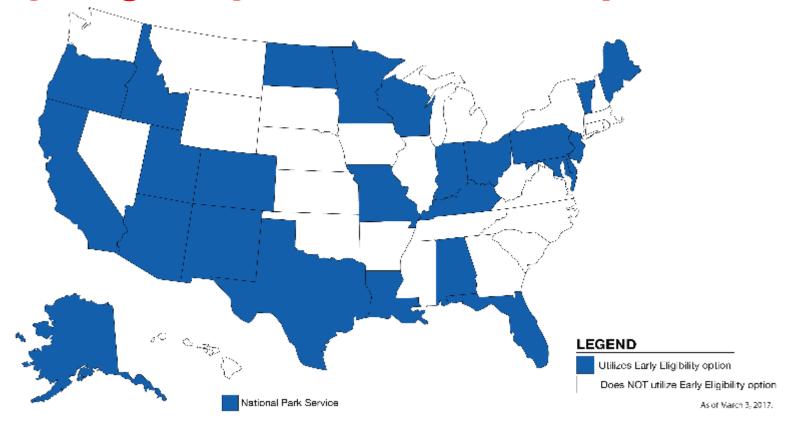


PATT is not the same as ATT

- PATT is specific to the ALS psychomotor examinations
 - Early Eligibility is optional

- ATT is specific to the cognitive exam (CBT)
 - Course completion is required for ATT to be issued
 - Early Eligibility is NOT an option for the ATT

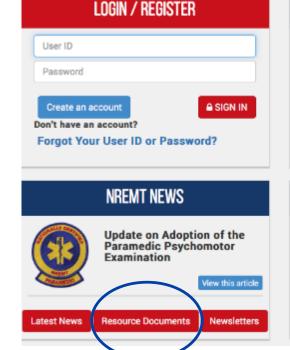

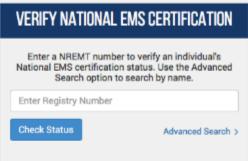


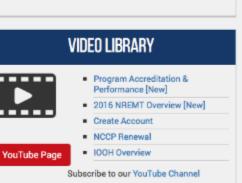

 - Limited number in each state
 - Monitor representatives' activity

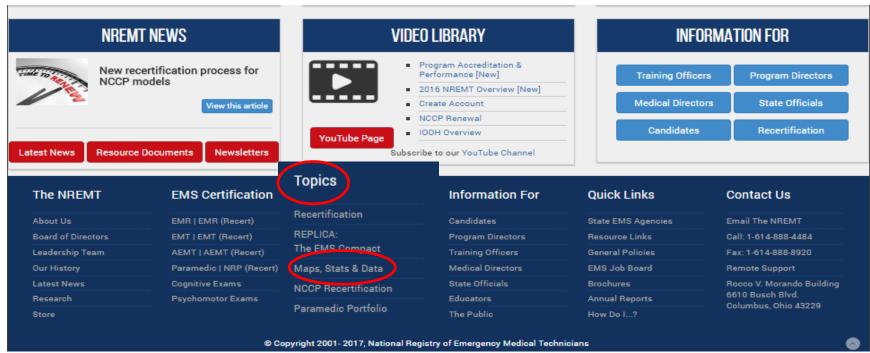

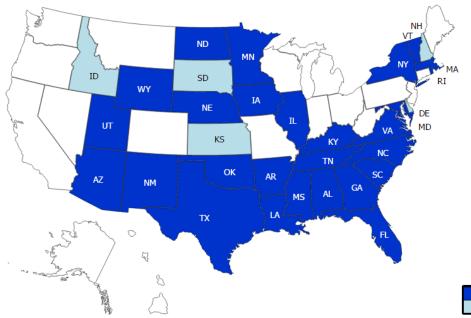
