 - No further updates regarding PEPP 4th edition currently waiting for direction from the AAP directly related to pandemic safety guidelines and in-person skills/testing
- EIIC Prehospital Pediatric Readiness Steering Committee Rachael Alter (NASEMSO)
 - Looking for agencies to pilot checklist. Any interested agencies can contact Rachael.
 - Goal to get it completed by Fall 2020.
- NAEMSP Equipment for Ground Ambulance Marc Minkler (ME)
 - Still working on the final draft of the equipment recommendations.
 - ENA and EMSC have approved it
 - NASEMSO Executive Board:
 - Concerned with the statement of "In addition to the items included in this position statement our organizations agree that, as modeled in the Iowa Administrative Code, "all EMS service programs shall carry equipment and supplies in quantities as determined by the medical director and appropriate to the service program's level of care and available certified EMS personnel and as established in the service program's approved protocols." (Line 139 on attached draft paper). The concern is that not all EMS agencies have a medical director with the requisite expertise and/or ability or statutory authority to determine the equipment and/or quantities. I suggested to the group changing to "In addition to the items included in this position statement our organizations agree that, as modeled in the Iowa Administrative Code, "all EMS service programs shall carry equipment and supplies in quantities as determined by the medical director, service leaders, regional and state EMS officials and appropriate to the service program's level of care and available certified EMS personnel and as established in the service program's approved protocols." At this time, Dr. Lyng has opted to not change the existing language and will resubmit to NASEMSO with other changes detailed below.

- They asked to add that "Hemostatic dressings are the preferred agent for wound packing". Evidence that hemostatic dressings are superior to plain gauze for packing and survivability is sparse. As such, there is a footnote referencing hemostatic dressings value but not listed as preferred
- They asked to include supplies for cricothyrotomy. Dr. Lyng felt that as this was not a universal skill across the country, and in keeping with minimums, it is not called out but is added as a footnote to include as local protocols allow.
- AAP and NAEMT still reviewing.
- Goal for completion is September 30, 2020
