CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL

President Keith Wages called the meeting to order at 11:01 a.m. Eastern time and Secretary Alisa Williams called roll. A quorum was present.

DISCUSSION

President Wages explained that because there was confusion over the vote about the recommended NEMSIS timeline, he has called the special meeting today. While a "motion to reconsider" is a tool to be used during the same meeting, he felt that the proceedings merited giving the Board a more focused opportunity to discuss and vote on the topic.

NEMSIS v.3.5 Proposed Timeline:

- 3.5.0 Requests Finalized May 2018
- 3.5.0 Candidate Release May 2019
- 3.5.0 Final Release Sept 2019
- 3.3.4 NEMSIS stops accepting data Sept 2019
- 3.5.0 Compliance Testing Readiness Nov 2019
- 3.5.0 Data acceptance starts Feb 2020
- 3.5.0 Software Release (Vendor) Feb 2021
- 3.5.0 Majority Implementation Jan 2022
- 3.4.0 NEMSIS stops accepting data Jan 2023

- ACTION: Kevin Putman moved on behalf of the Data Managers Council, seconded by Paul Patrick to approve Recommended (agile) NEMSIS v3.5 changes and the newly revised timeline. The motion passed unanimously (Dr. Ken Williams cast an absentee ballot in favor of the motion and Andy Gienapp abstained).
- ACTION: Joe Schmider moved, seconded by Kevin Putman for NASEMSO to send a letter to NHTSA requesting partnership to develop a strategic plan to move NEMSIS forward. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

Discussion suggested that a good solution would be to reach the point where NEMSIS can manage more than two versions of data at one time. It was noted that 2.2 and 3.4 are completely different platforms and given current varying use of versions among states, data is currently being lost because states are unable to report; it is hopeful that capability will increase in future.
