## DO

- Secure pediatric patients in an appropriate child restraint system
- Consider a child's age and weight when determining an appropriate restraint system
- Transport children who are not patients, properly restrained, in an alternate passenger vehicle, whenever possible
- Allow parents and caregivers to ride in the patient compartment with their child, but only if they are also properly restrained

## **DO NOT**

- TRANSPORT A CHILD ON A PARENT'S LAP ON THE STRETCHER
- Transport a child in a child restraint seat on the multi-occupant "bench seat" or "CPR Seat"
- Transport children in their own safety seats if the seat was involved in a crash, unless no other alternatives are available and the seat is undamaged
- Leave monitoring devices or other equipment unsecured in a moving EMS vehicle
