- 4. A copy of the State trauma Rules and Regulations with requirements to verify as a trauma center
- 5. Data Release Policy
- 6. An application to receive funding as a developing trauma center (if appropriate)
- 7. A sample letter of intent
- 8. A copy of the State application for designation
- 9. A sample letter for Survey instructions
- 10. Important documents for the Trauma Registry
  - a. Inclusion Criteria
  - b. Sample Abstraction Sheet
  - c. A copy of the NTDS Data Dictionary
  - d. The New Mexico Data Dictionary

## 11. A sample Memorandum of agreement

I put together a "Resource" book with the above information and then I have a 4 – 6 hours mandatory course that all New Trauma Coordinators must attend at my office.
