Your NEMSIS Password

If you forgot the password, you can reset it by following these steps:

- 1. Go to the password reset site <u>https://reset.utahdcc.org</u>
- 2. Click on 'Reset Password'
- 3. Enter your username (tclay) under Domain User Name
- 4. Enter the characters as you see in the picture displayed (letters are not case sensitive)
- 5. Click the Continue button
- 6. A screen showing your default e-mail is displayed. (If you have more than one email, click on the drop-down box and select the one you prefer)
- 7. Click the Continue button (an email will be sent to you with the verification code)
- 8. Enter the verification code from the email you received and click Continue
- 9. Leave Old Password field empty
- 10. Enter a New Password
- 11. Enter the password again under Confirm the New Password
- 12. Click on Reset Password button

You will receive another email confirming the password reset has been done.
