 - Ridgely offered their algorithm

NEMESIS TAC

- Clay reported that NHTSA is removing the need to move their data to the Microsoft AZURE Cloud.
- Clay asked “What is the difficult item for moving to a new version?”
 - Dan stated they have over 800 services and 10 different vendors which just getting them to accept the change is hard.
 - Kevin did not feel going from 3.4 to 3.5 will be that hard. Nothing like 2.2.1 to 3.
 - Sharon felt the biggest issue was the short timeline.
 - Chip agreed with Kevin.
 - Dan-IL suggested if we could have a national Schematron or with limited state revisions.
 - Clay asked if they could do something with the vendors to help ease the transition.
