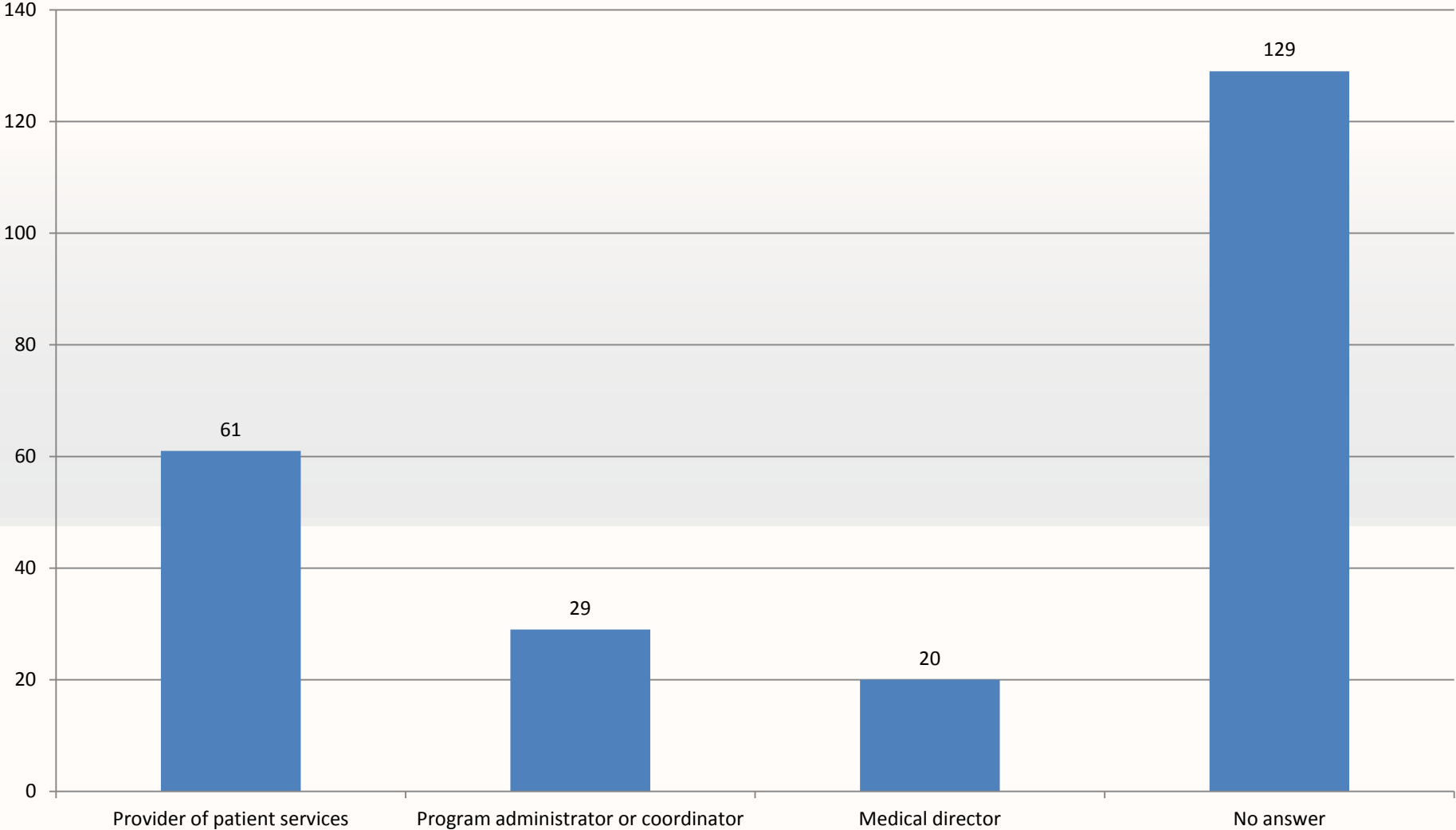
## Overview

- 5 international responses (not included in the charts and graphs)

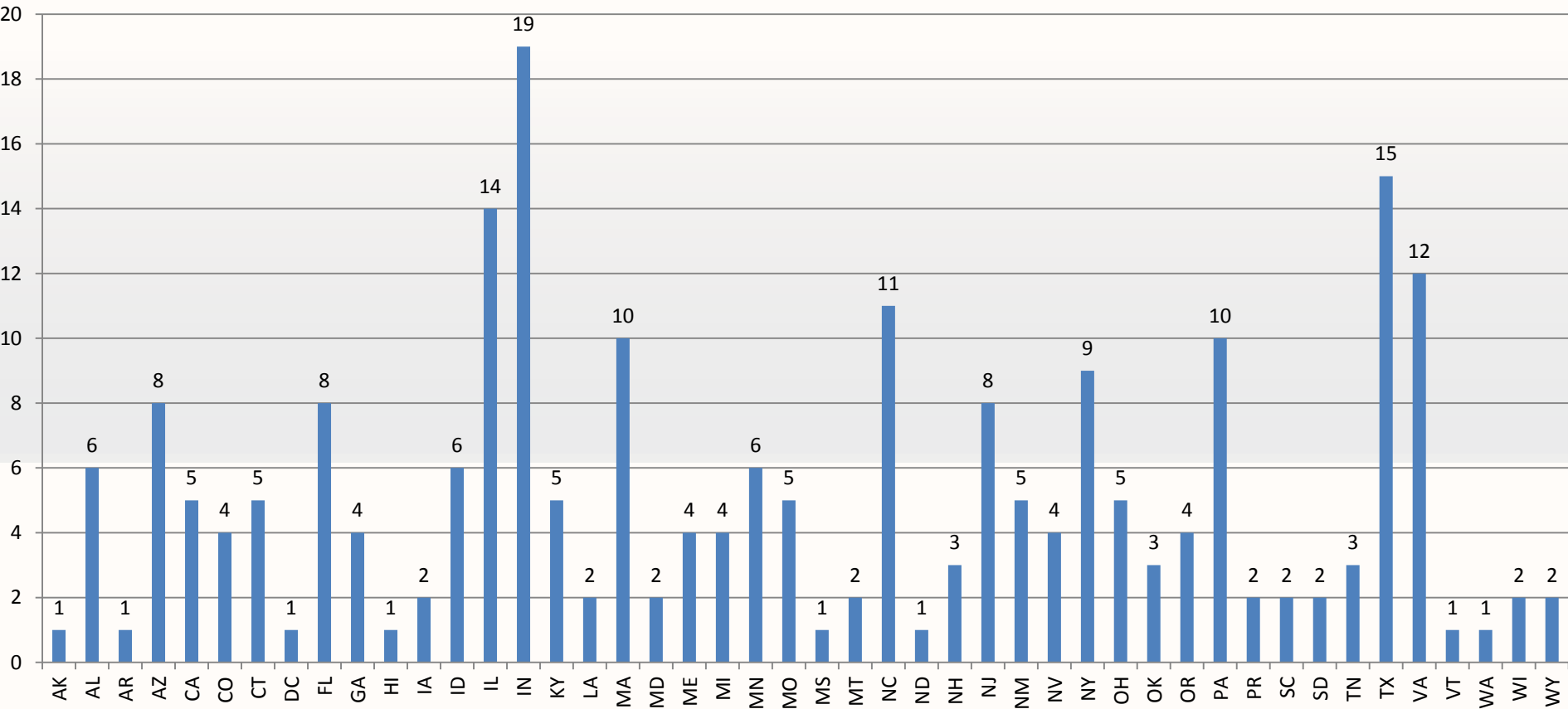

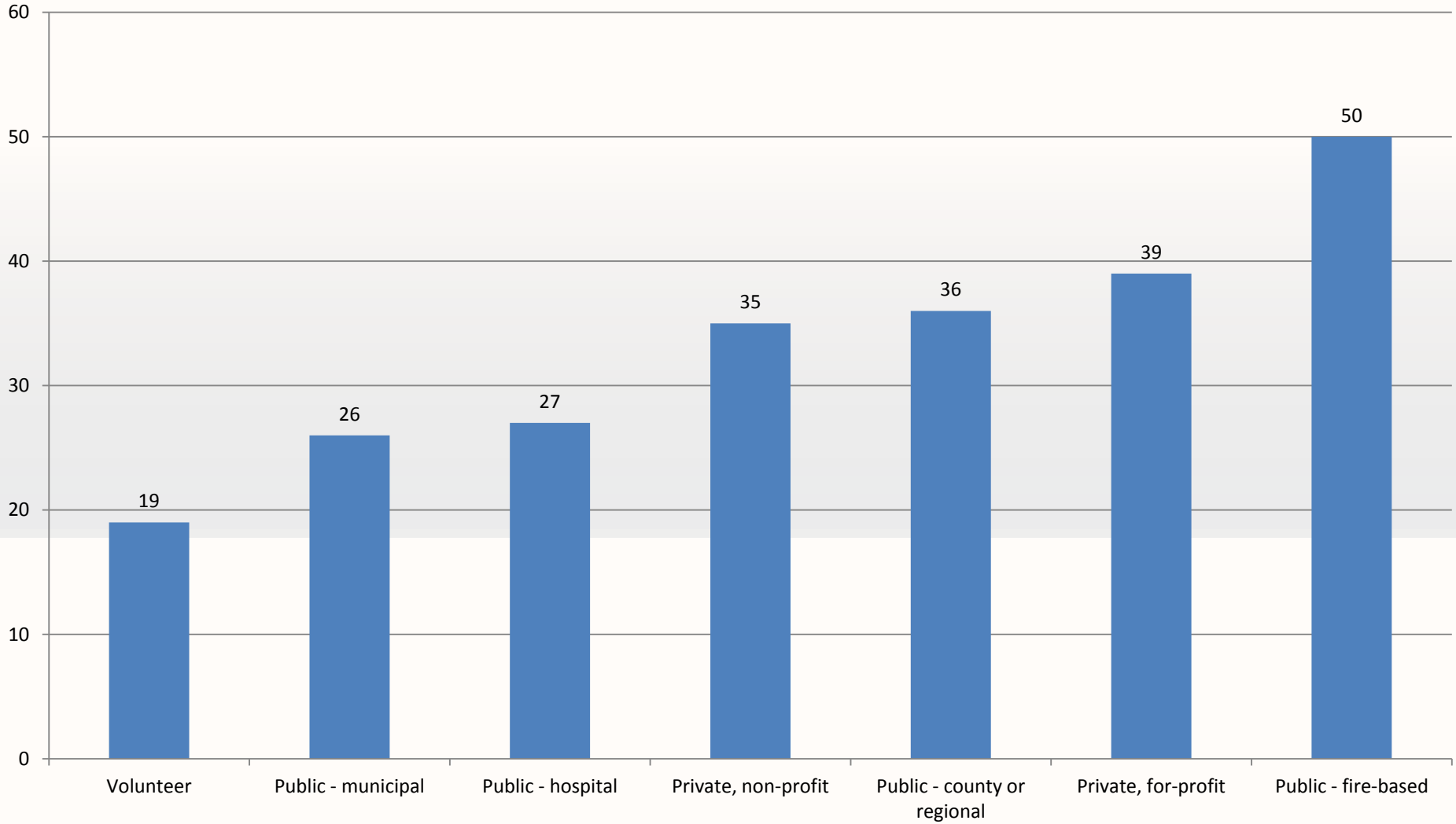
## Top 5 states with the most programs

- North Carolina - 11

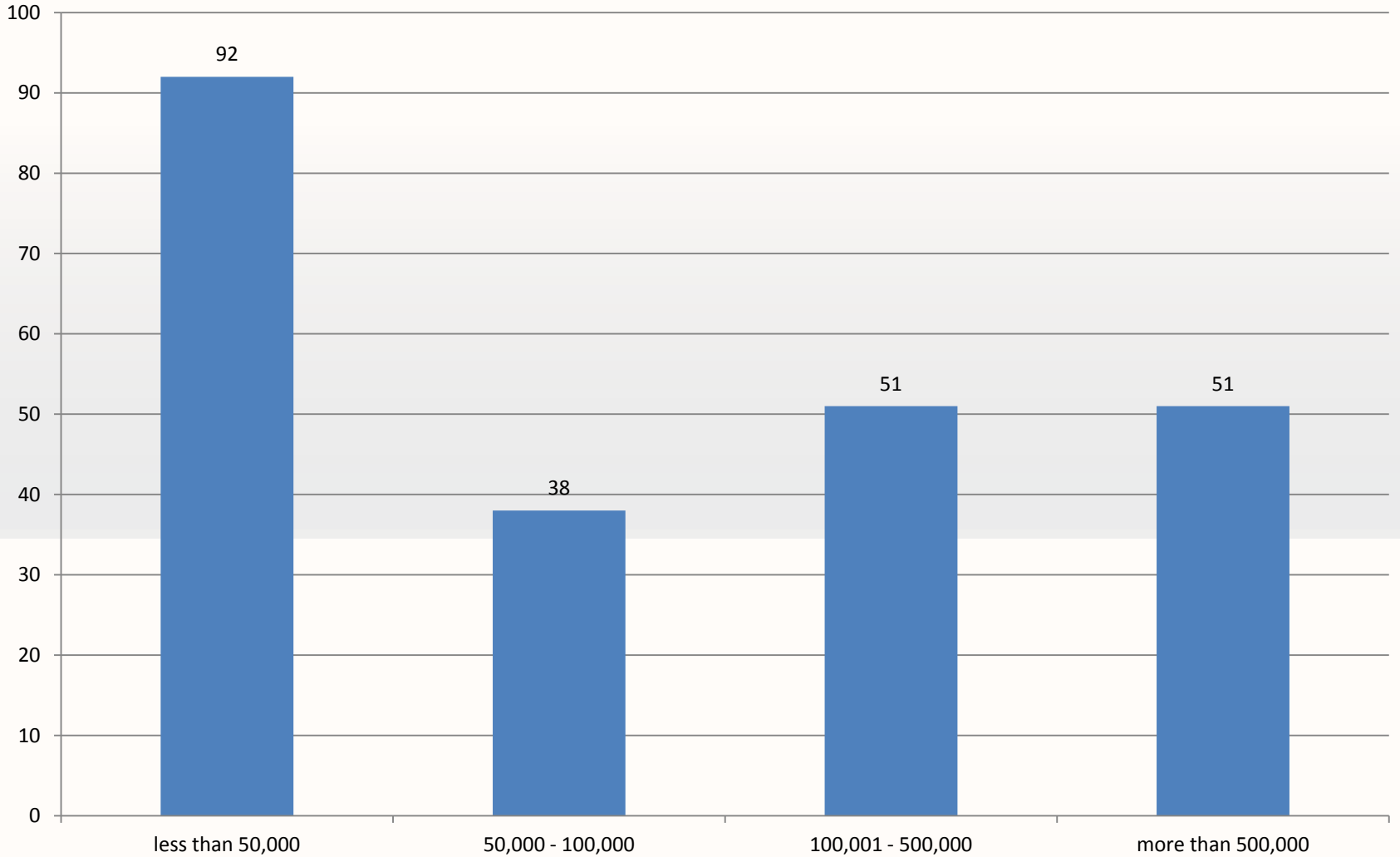

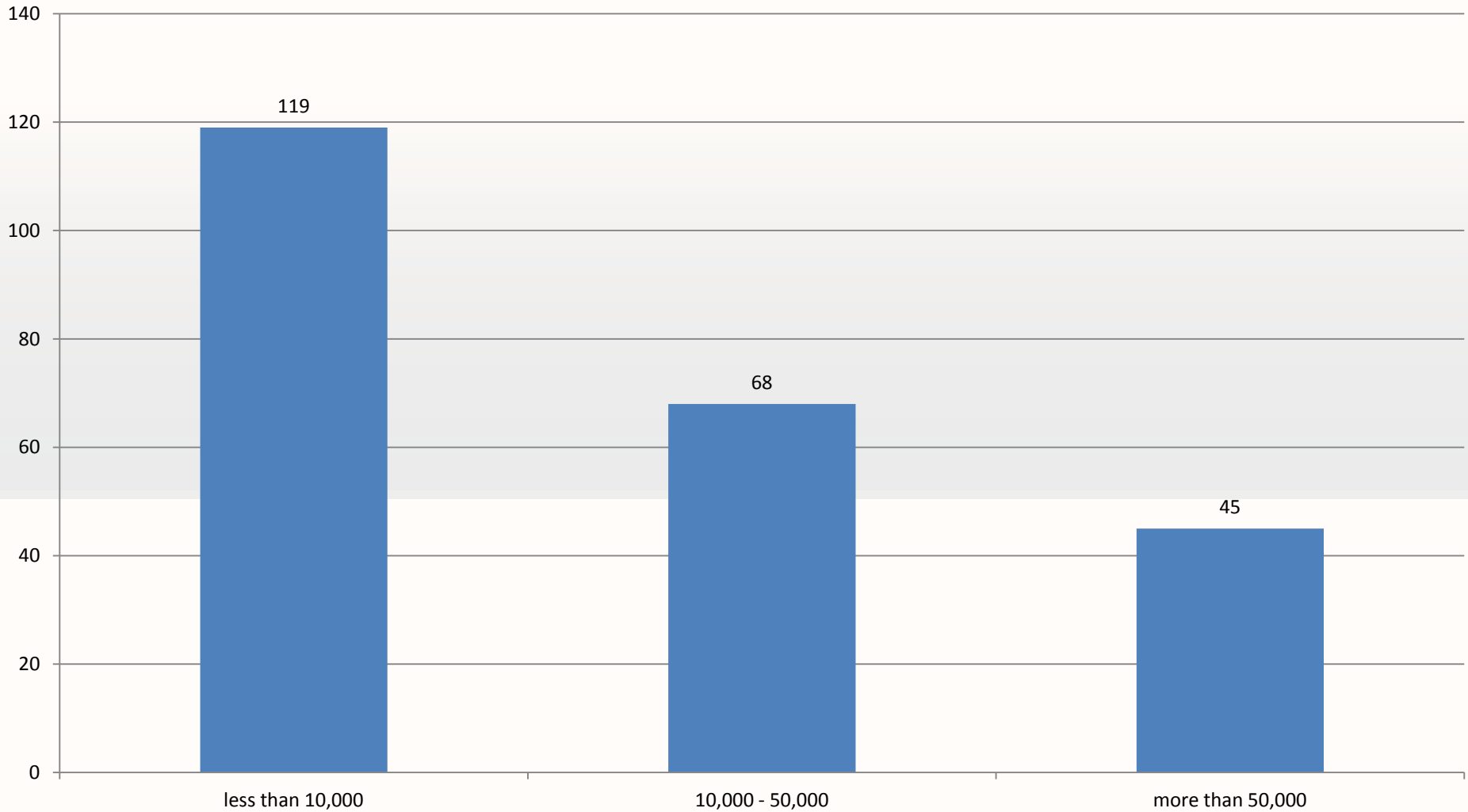
## CP Programs by population served





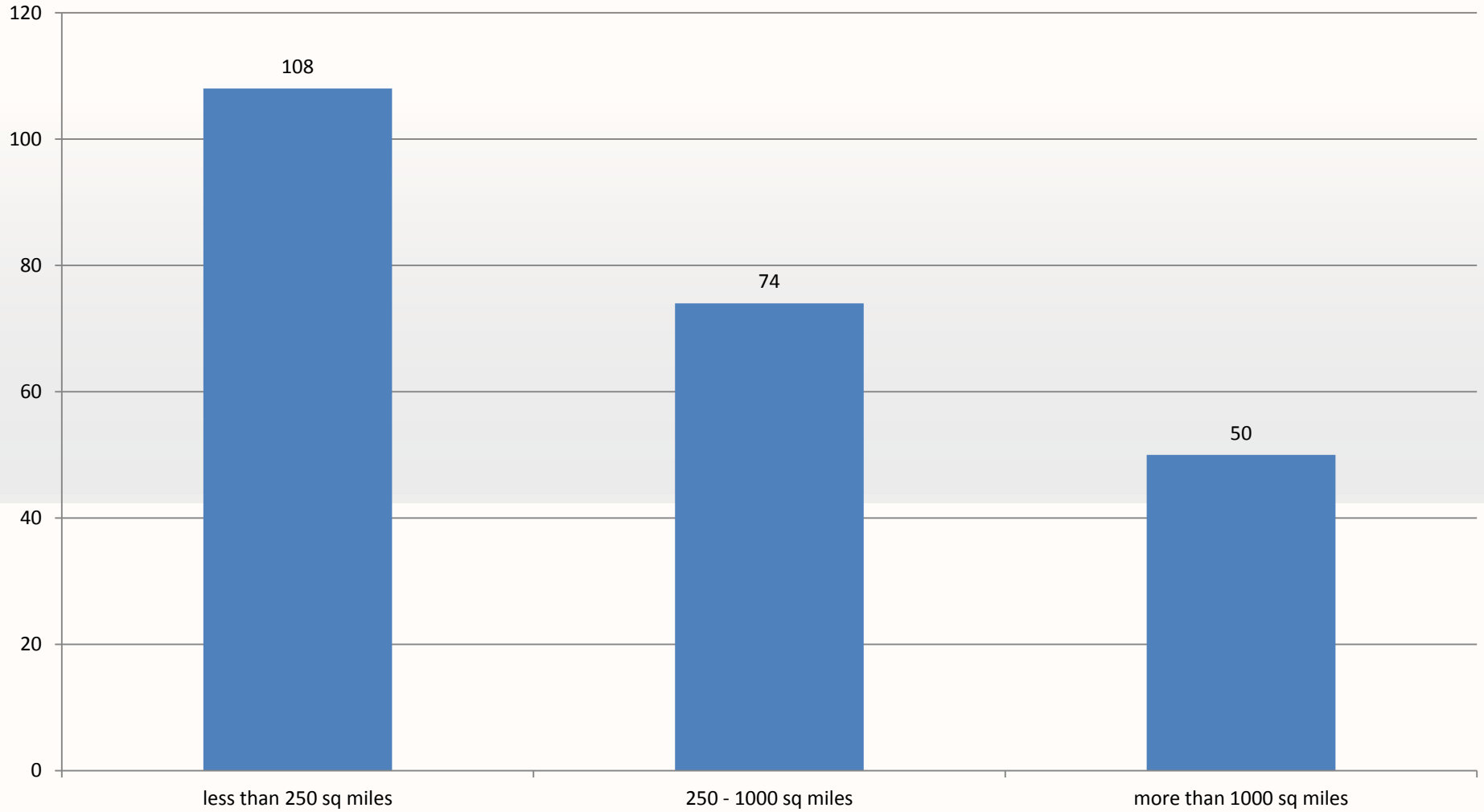

## CP Programs by annual call volume



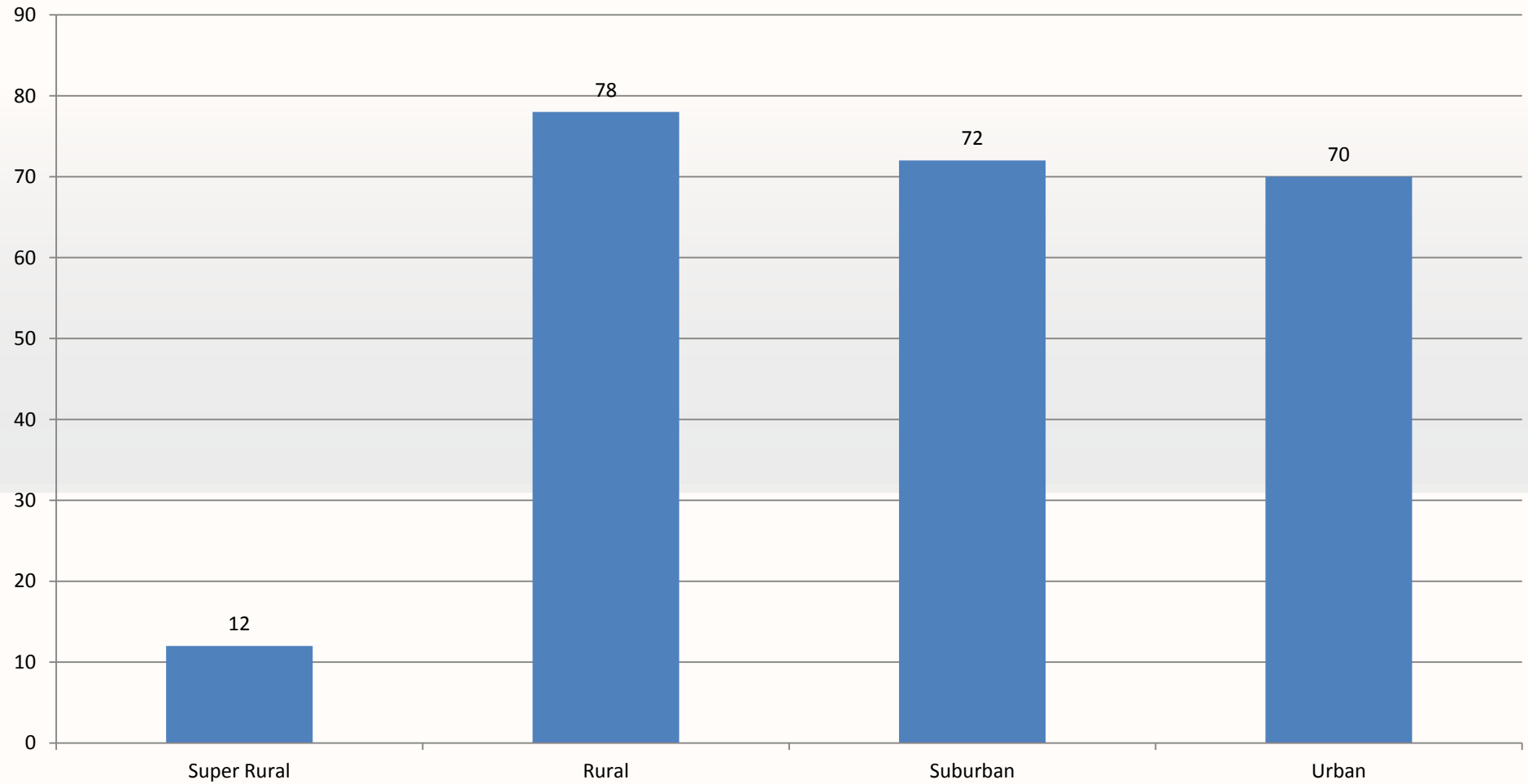

## Size of area served



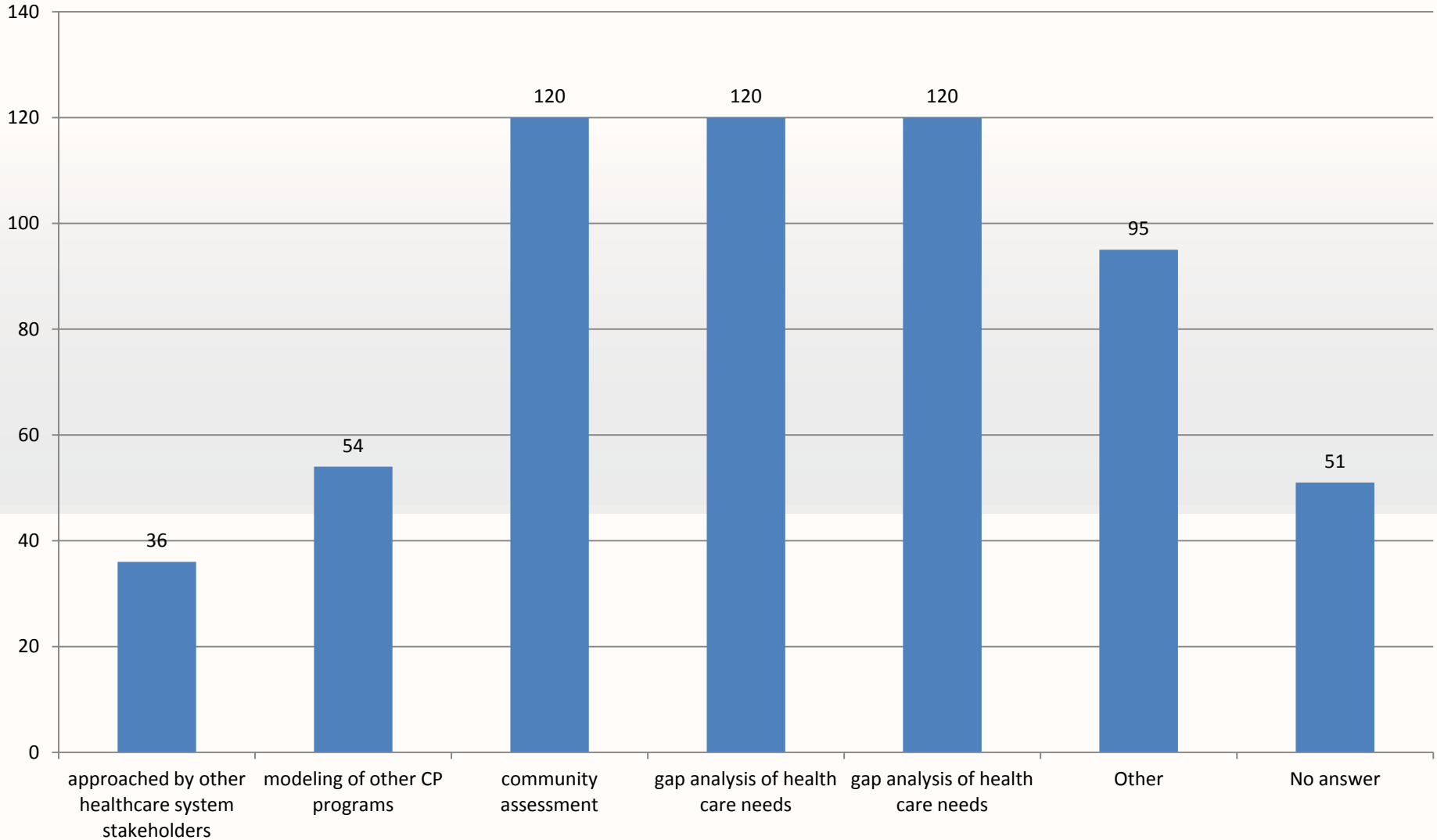

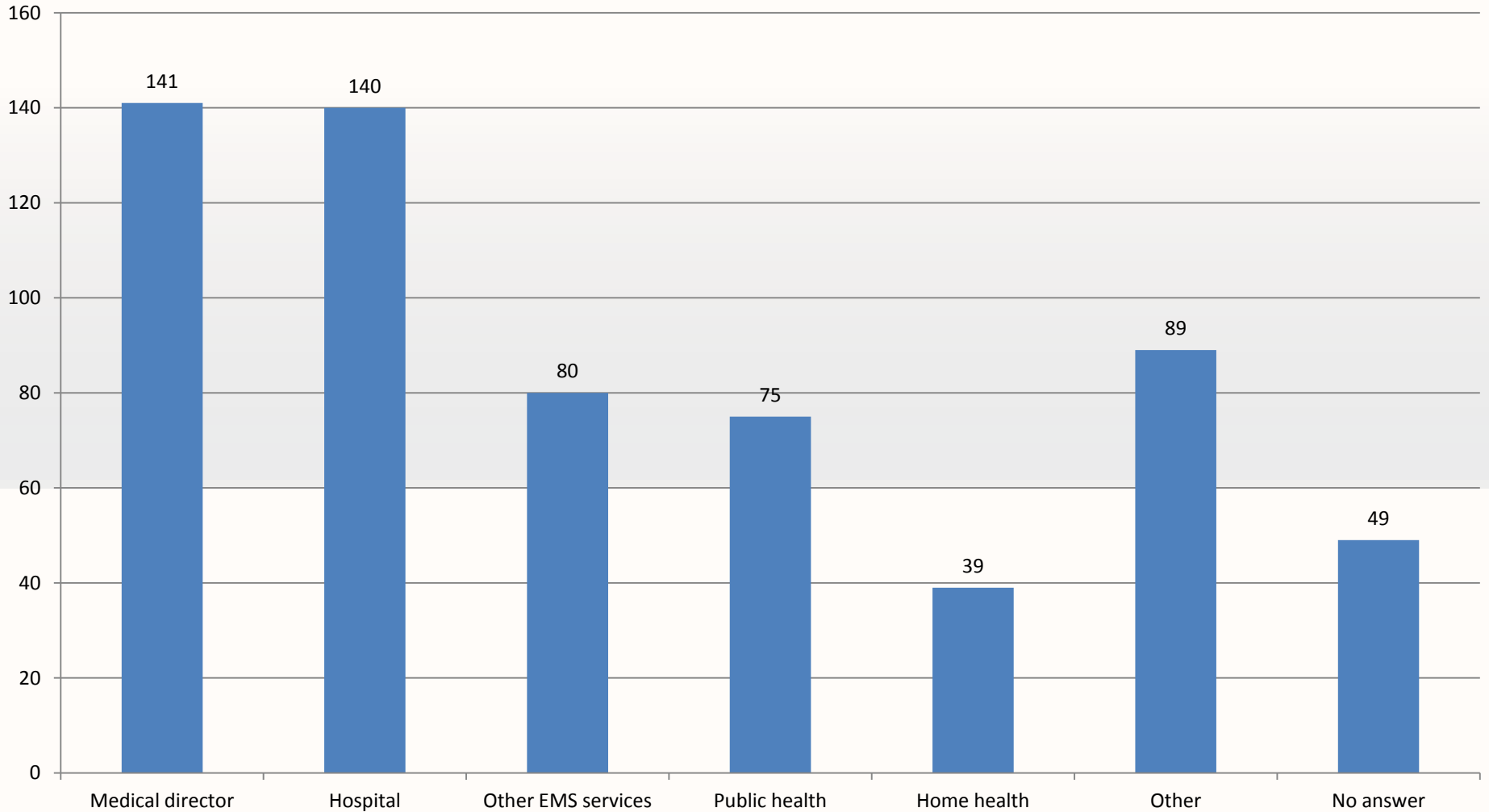

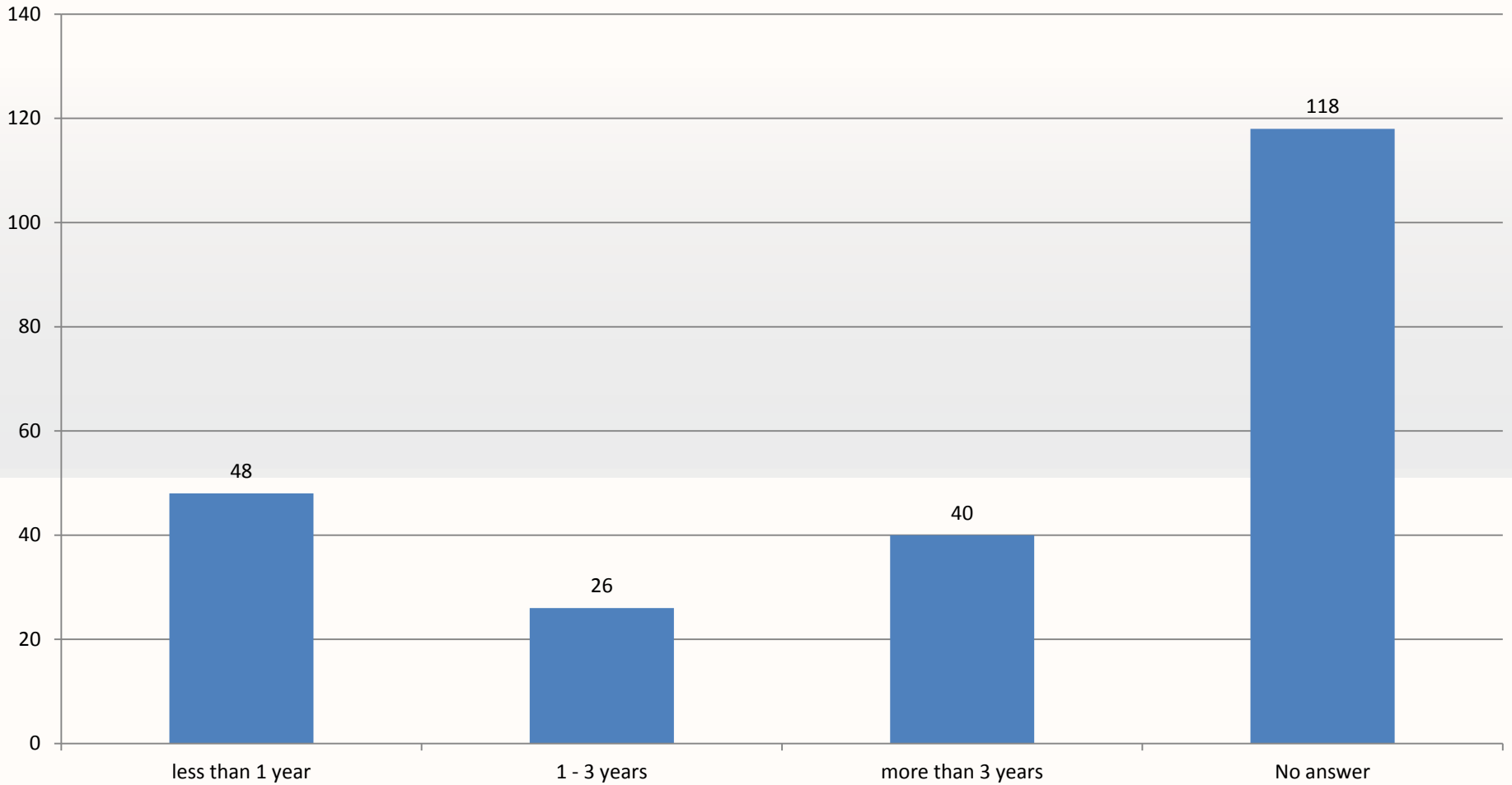

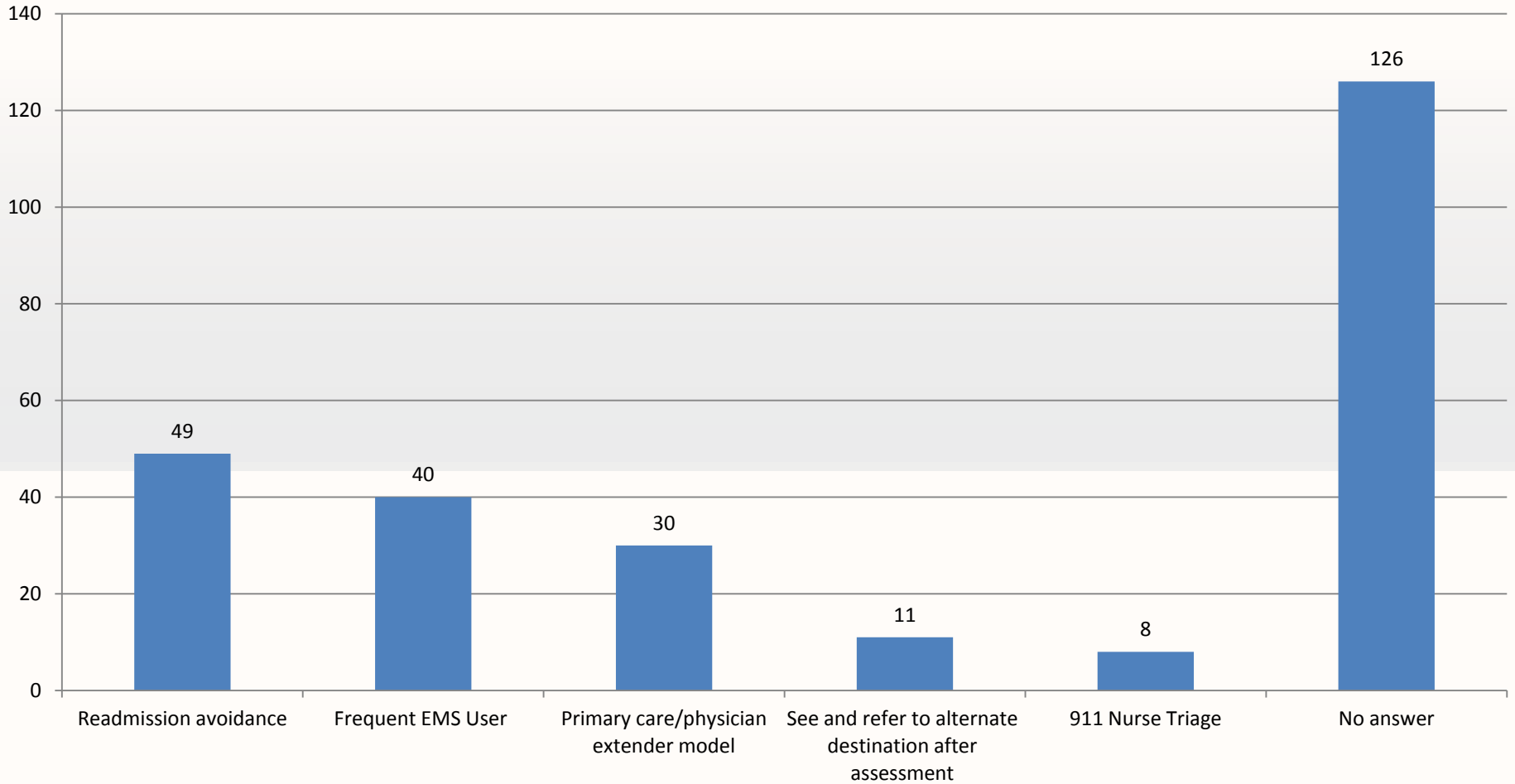

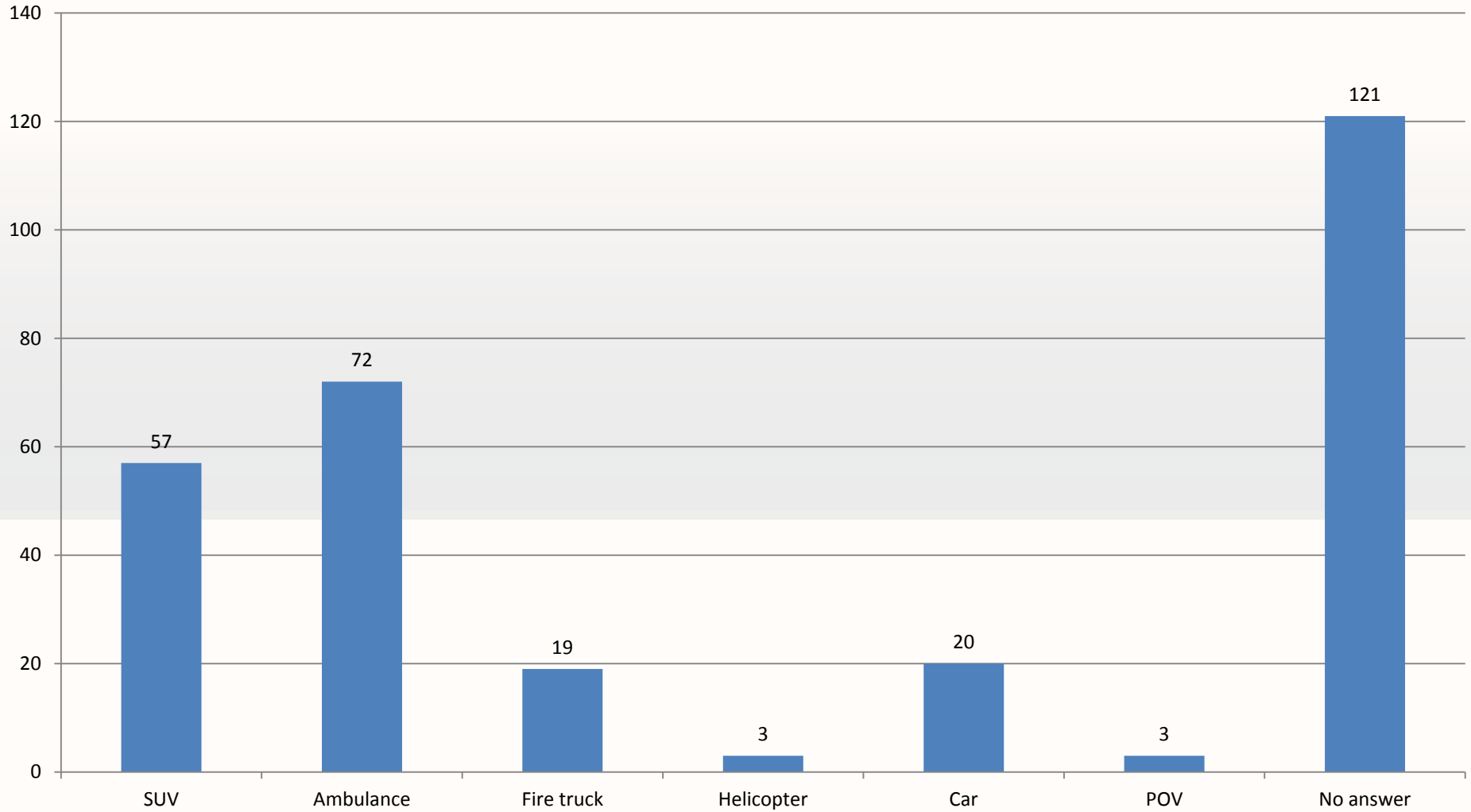

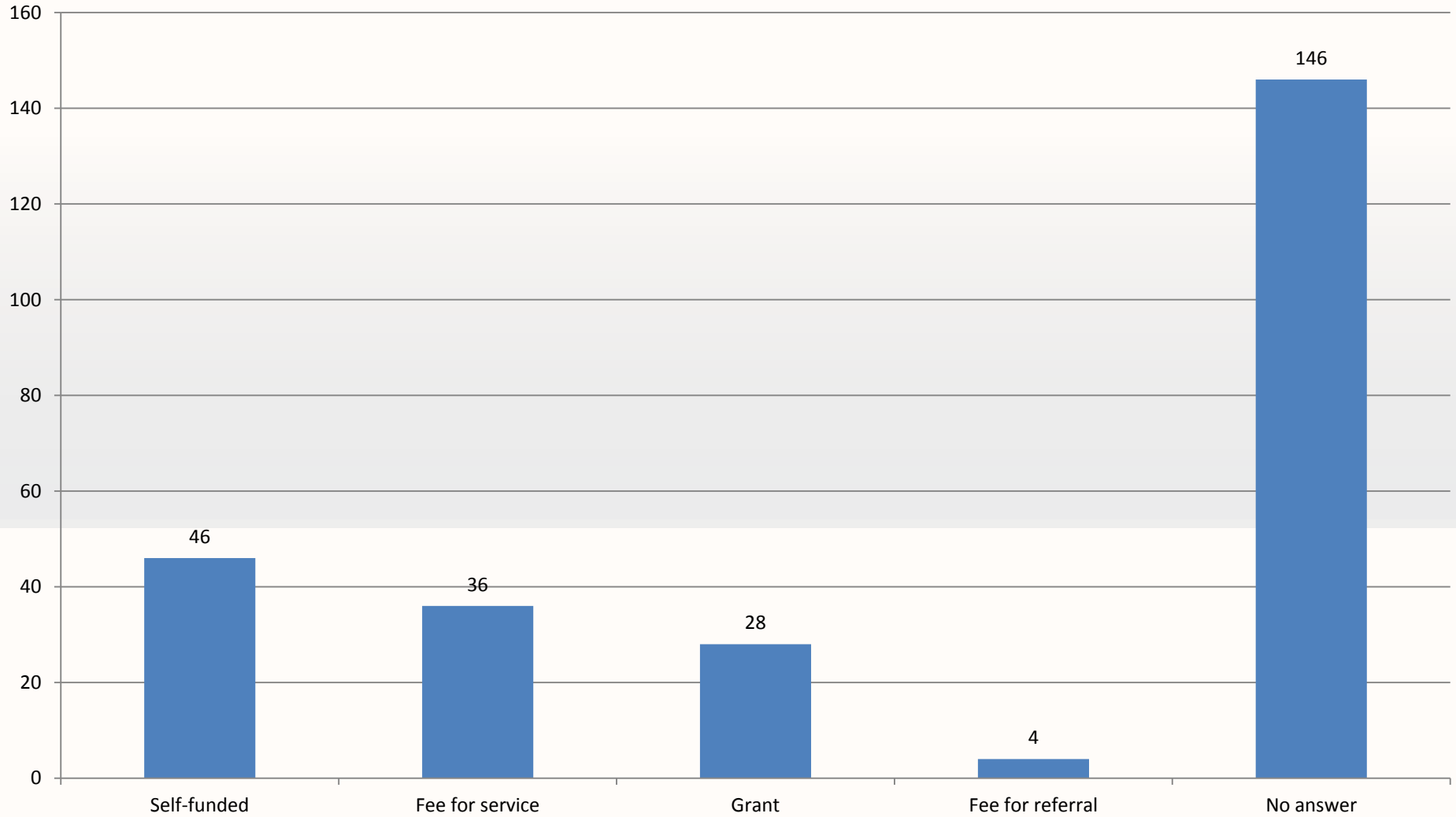
## Type of vehicle used





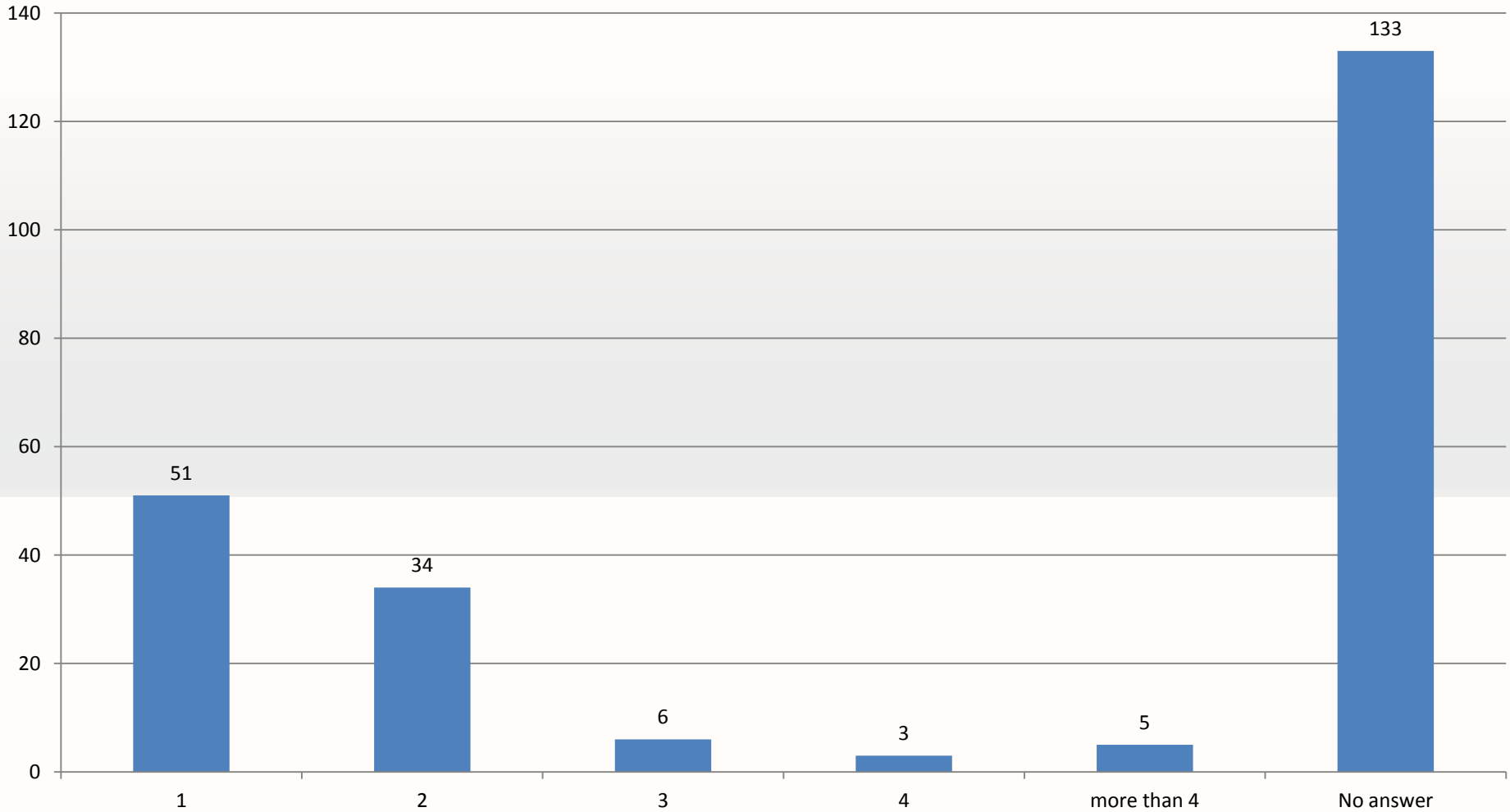

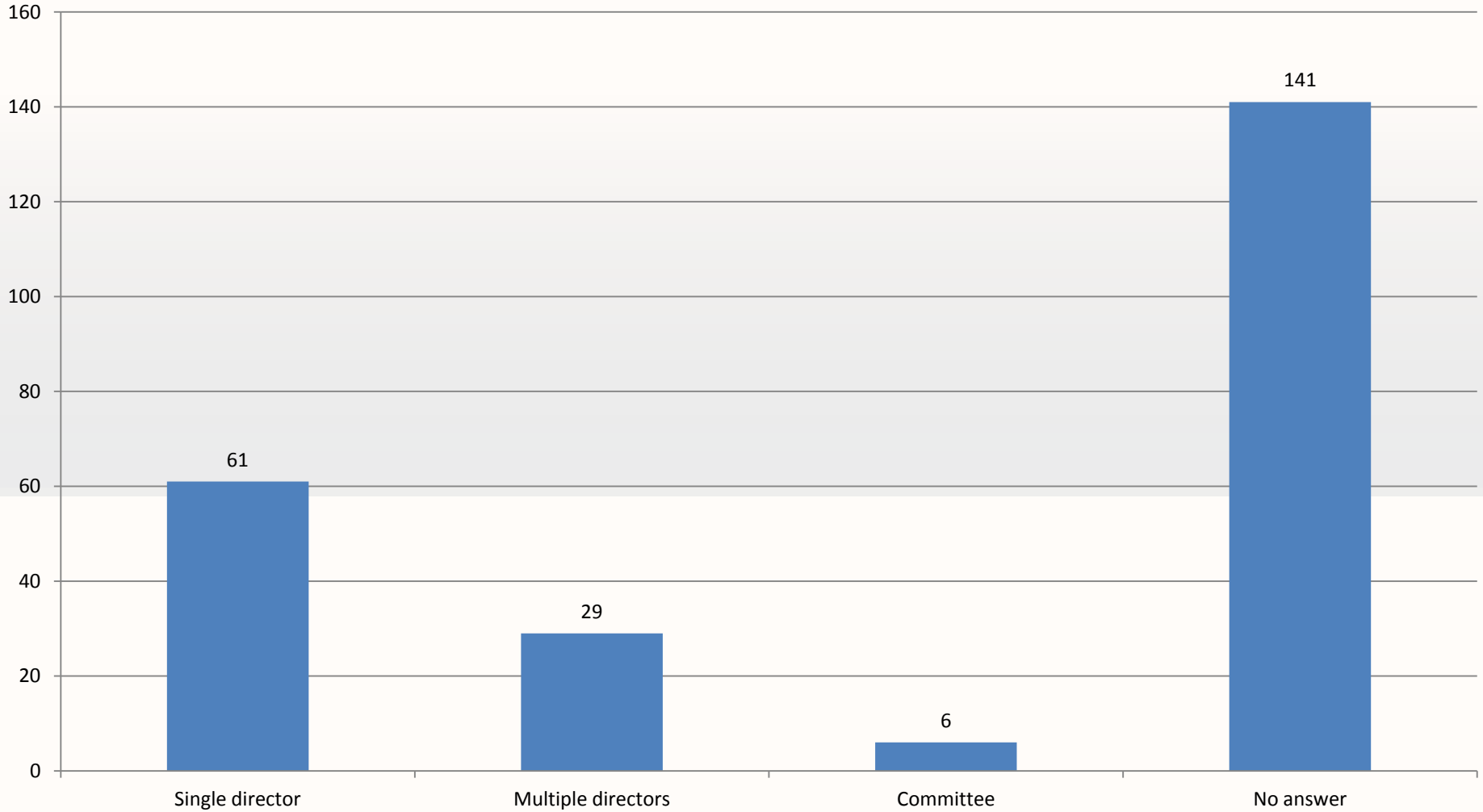

How many CP providers respond at a time



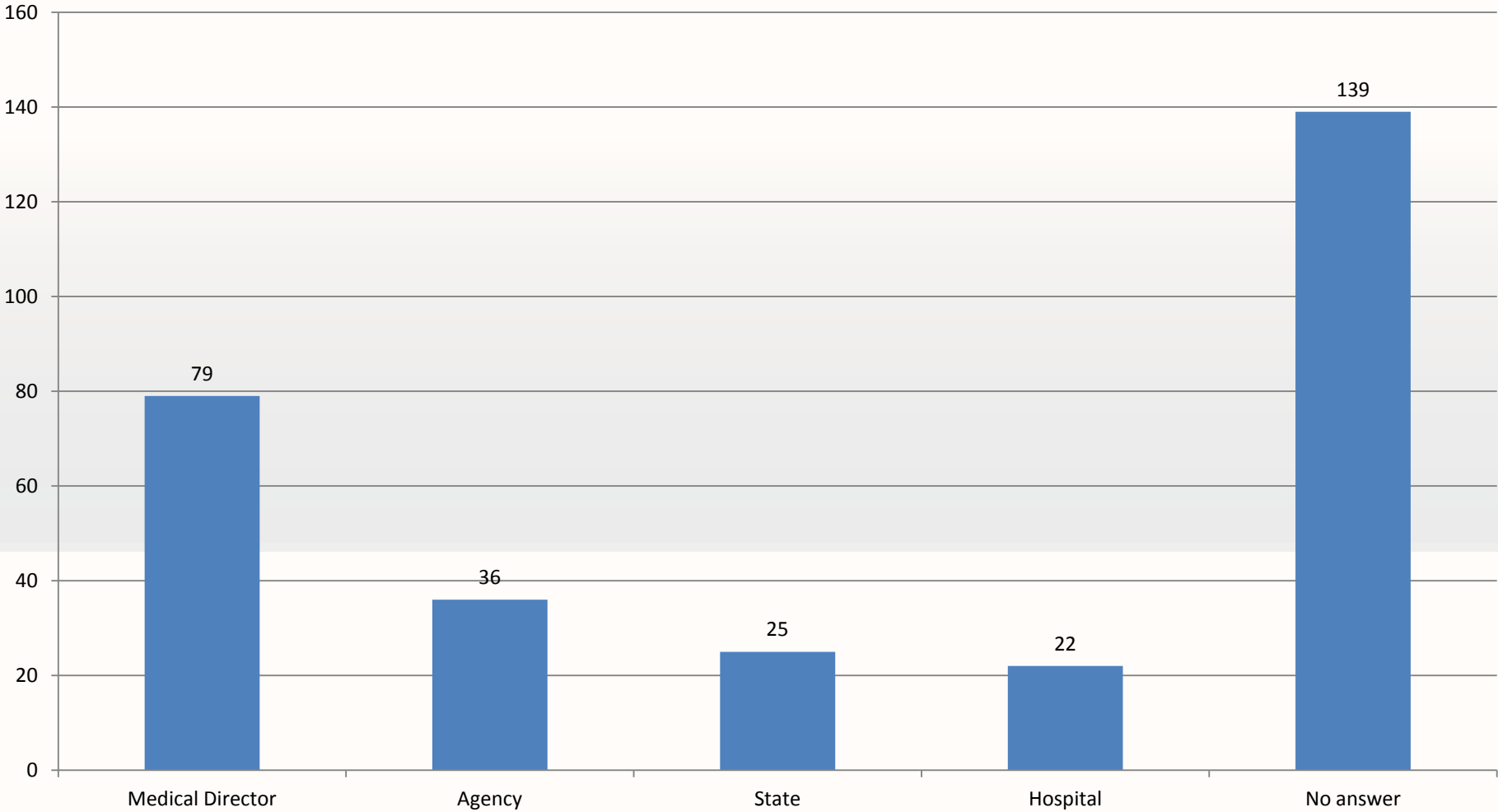
