Compass

- Measures were discussed and are open for public comment. Request from Nick for data managers to talk to State vendors on desired format for Compass measures for display:

- State Level
- Regional View
- EMS Agency View
- EMS Professional View

A concern was brought forward on the cardiac arrest measures asking for things that aren't captured (depth, time related to CPR, etc.) At end of day measures need to be evidence based, important to measure and report, feasible, and address areas of Triple Aim (Cost of Care, Population Health, Quality of Care). All these will be considered when the process is done.

Model Minimum Uniform Crash Criteria (MMUCC)

- Steve brought up the current request for revisions to these guidelines. Andy Fulton from Delaware, Jay Ostby from Wyoming and Chuck Happel from Wisconsin agreed to be part of a review committee.

Extended Data Definitions

- Lindsey introduced this topic and thanked those that were part of the recommendations. Initial area discussed was eDisposition.12. Recommended adding a code for *...Transported by another vehicle* and deprecating *...Transported by Law Enforcement* or *...Transported by Private Vehicle*. Consensus was the group agreed with the recommendation.
- Lindsey requested the work group to meet one more time before providing to NASEMSO.
