1.	Welcome and Roll Call	Joe Schmider, Chair welcomed committee members
2.	FICEMS update	Joe attended his first committee FICEMS meeting and will be a part of the Domestic Preparedness FICEMS Committee; this committee meets once a month. FICEMS main topic for this meeting was the Strategic Plan for FICEMS along with goals and objectives and the 2 nd topic was should the EMS Agenda for the Future be updated. 3.	Interstate Compact Update	A meeting was conducted on June 10 th in Chicago for State EMS Directors and states legal counsel. The compact is moving forward with many states looking to sign on. Over 60 people attended. Next step is having states introduce the final draft to their states. Discussion occurred concerning whether or not there is a need for this. Staff identified the issue of EMTs coming in for forest fires, air ambulances and federal EMT's that come into a state was the impetus to the compact. Cost may be an issue.
3.	Credentialing Committee	The committee is developing a flow chart and detail document for credentialing purposes so that there will be consistency in the process, by states, when issuing credentials/recognition for specialized EMS Provider groups. The draft document will be available for the annual meeting in Ohio.
4.	Rural Domestic Preparedness Com	No report given.
5.	EMS Preparedness Gap Committee	Leslee and Joe gave an overview of the final committee meeting that took place on June 25 th and 26 th . The final draft document is on track to be submitted to DHS and NASEMSO in August. There are 10 goals/priorities in the document along with how to meet these goals/gaps.
6.	Eastern State Mutual Aid conference call update	John Donahue discussed their first pre-event call with Hurricane Arthur over the July 4 th weekend. The groups other priority is to preparing a list of each states list of resources that they can share with the other states along with updating their emergency contact list.

Staff also assisted with the development/input of NASEMSSO's position on law enforcement administering NARCAN.</p> <p>EMAC, John from Maryland and Mel from Ohio will look at national available documents and if possible develop a sample EMAC budget projection so that when states reply to an EMAC request there will be a budget model available so that states can reply quicker.</p> <p>Border Issues; Committee members asked if the committee could get a national briefing at the annual committee meeting on EMS issues that addressed. Some states have been asked to prepare to receive these people and states do not know what to expect when it comes to additional workload for the EMS system. Joe will try to get a Federal partner to attend the DP committee annual meeting.</p>
