1.	<b>Welcome and Roll Call</b>	Joe Schmider called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. He apologized for the change of meeting dates and thanked everyone for participation.
2.	<b>Approve Agenda and Meeting Record</b>	Meeting minutes from April were approved and they are posted on the web.
3.	<b>Meeting at the West Wing</b>	Joe informed the group about Leslee and his visit to the West Wing. We represented the Association at a committee that is developing guidelines for first responders at a mass shooting and/or an IED explosion. It was all positive and the committee was eager to hear from EMS. Both Joe and Leslee provided input and ideas that should be addressed in this guideline.
4.	<b>FEMA/National Ambulance Contract</b>	While Leslee and Joe were in DC, they had the opportunity to meet with Rick Flynn from FEMA. He is the new person in charge of the NAC. The meeting was positive and Rick was eager to work with NASEMSO to assist in resolving issues that occur with activation of the NAC. This includes notification of states when their ambulance providers are leaving to respond to a state declared disaster
5	<b>State Declared Disasters and Position Paper</b>	This draft of this paper will be on the agenda at our committee meeting at the annual meeting. The purpose of this paper is to identify the need for states that are next to a disaster state to provide assistance, if needed prior to an EMAC request or deployment of EMS resources from the NAC. This type of situation occurred during Storm Sandy when Pa. sent ambulances to NJ prior to a state declaration. NASEMSO has tasked the DP committee to come up with an issue paper and a position on this type of response.
6	<b>Credentialing Committee</b>	This committee has not met.
7	<b>Rural Domestic Preparedness</b>	Chris Bell from Vermont was not on the DP call so no report was provided.
8	<b>Review of the DP Funding survey results</b>	Rachael presented the draft results from the DP survey. There was a lot of discussion on the results and future questions that should be asked. Rachael will make the edits and then will submit for final approval. Everyone thanked Rachael for an excellent job.
9	<b>Communication Drill</b>	Joe informed the group that we are going to be conducting a no notice communication drill, probably in Sept. We do this in order to test our emergency contact list and assure that we can keep our
