NHTSA Office of EMS

- Eric highlighted the COVID-19 dashboard on the FICEMS website.
- American Heart Association “Don’t die of doubt” program has approached for data. The TAC will be reaching out as was done similarly for ILI.
- Developing a PPE data tracking process the first of which focuses on agency level availability. Output data available through Tableau. There was discussion about collecting this data from existing state resource management systems. Additional focuses are operational solvency and agencies closing.

NEMSIS TAC

- Discussion on Suggested Lists to Defined Lists – Clay gave an update and examples for several elements.
- Release of State/County Identifiers for Public Health Surveillance – Clay informed the members about a 20-page document, currently under review, developed with Page, Wolfbert, & Wirth that can be provided to entities about data exchange.
- Legal Opinion on HIPPA Barriers to Sharing Data – Clay spoke about a draft resolution for the sharing about symptoms and impressions. It should be available next month.
- Identifying PPE Needs
