EMS CLINICAL GUIDELINES: **PURPOSE**

- Patient-centric

- Resource to clinical practice
- Use or adapt for use on a state, regional or local level
- Benchmark performance of EMS practice

- Revised document with updated Resuscitation chapter released and posted in **August 2016**

NAEMSO NATIONAL MODEL

EMS CLINICAL GUIDELINES: 2ND GENERATION

- Invitation to NAEMSO Medical Directors Council for new and reappointed workgroup members
 - Invitation to national EMS physician medical direction stakeholder organizations for new and reappointed workgroup members
 - Maintenance of the currency of the document
 - Collection and review of new EMS research literature and data
 - Update of the Resuscitation chapter due to the 2015 American Heart Association guidelines

NASEMSO NATIONAL MODEL EMS CLINICAL GUIDELINES: **NEXT STEPS**

- Inclusion of additional evidence-based guidelines
 - Inclusion of additional consensus-based guidelines
 - Measurable patient outcomes
 - Measurable use and/or adoption of the guidelines by the EMS community
 - Enhanced incorporation of collaborative EMS systems (e.g. **NEMSIS**)
