

Honorary Council Status Policy Draft for NASEMSO Board Consideration

- May be offered to an individual whom the Council feels provides valuable input to the Council based on experience and expertise
- The individual must be and remain an Associate Member of NASEMSO
- Honorary Council status is by invitation of Council Chair after concurrence of voting Council members
 - Invitation must be approved by NASEMSO Board President in advance
- In addition to the NASEMSO Associate Membership benefits, an Honorary Council status member will be granted access to the following:
 - Council agendas and meeting minutes
 - Council meetings
 - Council listserv and other communications platforms
- Honorary Council status members do not have voting rights
- Honorary Council status membership is for a term of 2 years coinciding with the Associate Member term
 - Status may be renewed at Honorary Council member's request and concurrence of Council/Chair and the NASEMSO President
 - There are no term limits for renewals for Honorary Council status members who remain in good standing
- Honorary Council status membership may be revoked at the termination of NASEMSO Associate membership, at any time by the Council Chair after concurrence by voting Council members, or at the request of the Honorary Council status member
- Honorary Council status member may not use this relationship for personal or professional financial gain, and may be called upon to address any appearance of conflict of interest if such a condition emerges.
