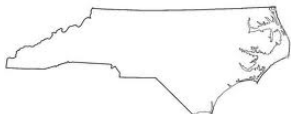

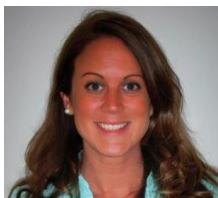

At a glance

Pediatric Emergency & Trauma Care

- Updating the "Transfer of the Pediatric Patient" Guidelines for hospitals.

Pediatric Education & Training

- Currently finishing up a "helmet extraction course and sports related injuries" train the trainer video. Working with a subcommittee to provide an online course for EMS agencies, Use of Epinephrine during Anaphylaxis.

Pediatric Data & Quality Improvement

- Continue to work on several data projects, however during our EMS for Children Strategic Planning Meeting in March 2017, we will have a better idea of the topics once the Advisory Council meets.

Pediatric Disaster Preparedness

- Working with the NC OEMS Disaster Preparedness Program and DHHS Public Health to work on a pediatric disaster exercise in which we can combine the three areas of government and test our pediatric resources in the State.

Other

- The Program is purchasing Handtevy Pediatric Bags to be distributed throughout rural EMS agencies.
