

Contractor agrees to:

- a. Provide consultation and technical assistance for all medical aspects related to planning, education, and evaluation of the statewide Trauma system which will include verbal and/or written communication to providers/trauma centers on specific Performance Improvement (PI) issues.
- b. Provide consultation and technical assistance for the Trauma System's regional state performance improvement process including:
 - i. Attending all regional meetings via BTWAN
 - ii. Review trauma registry data/cases prior to meetings
 - iii. Evaluate the PI process and provide technical assistance for changes to the process
- c. Serve as an expert advocate for efficient, effective, and evidence-based care throughout the state.
- d. Provide education on emerging issues in Trauma to local and regional EMS and Trauma medical directors and present at the State Trauma Conference and State EMS Conference.
- e. Interact with local, regional, state, and national EMS and Trauma authorities to oversee that standards, needs, and requirements are met and resource utilization serves to optimize efficient, effective, and evidence-based medical care.
- f. Attend American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma (ACS COT) and National Association of State EMS Officials (NASEMSO) meetings.
- g. Participate in legislative initiatives related to the statewide Trauma System.
