2. Fatigue in EMS (Kathy Robinson)

First phase of the project- the evidence based guidelines and performance measures are finished and have fully completed the peer review process. A special fatigue supplement to Prehospital Emergency Care is expected early 2018 but the online version will become available for one year, early (free) access to the public by the end of October/early November. After that, a subscription will be required. We will be sure to notify everyone of the link and access as soon as available.

Phase 2 includes an experimental study that will test elements of the guidelines that will commence this Fall.

Phase 3 includes a biomathematical scheduling tool based on the results of the study, will be made available for free to the EMS community.
